Feeder and Equipment Surcharge (FES) - Revision

Dear Valued Customers,

Swire Shipping relies on feeder partners to extend our network beyond our core service areas, including Asia, Europe, Africa and the Indian Subcontinent. Feeder rates have increased sharply in recent weeks, creating significant and unsustainable cost pressure. To maintain service continuity and reliability on affected lanes, Swire Shipping will introduce a Feeder and Equipment Surcharge (FES).

The FES will apply to Bills of Lading with an on-board date on or after **08 April 2026**.

Lanes regulated by the Federal Maritime Commission, will be subject to the applicable regulatory notice period.
